Shastha-O-Kalyan Sangstha (SKS) was established in 1986 and is located at Goshairhat Upazila in Shariatpur. The organization is registered with the NGO Affairs Bureau, Social Welfare and Family Planning Department. It is affiliated with Partners in Health Development (PHD) alliance, Peoples Health Movement (PHM) & International Aids Society (IAS). The Gender focus staffs are equipped with need-based training, especially to provide health services in the locality. The organization has a gender balanced executive committee. The strategic plan for five years was refined last in September 2002 in order to meet the requirements of the community. It addressed a heightened priority given to the hard core poor, gender equality, and quality of care, cost effectiveness and sustainability of the organization. In addition, the organization has developed its personnel policy, financial guideline, capacity building checklists (CBCL), monitoring and supervision tools based on Quality of Care (QOC). Under the assistance of Bangladesh Population and Health Consortium (BPHC) and PHD, the organization is conducting periodic monitoring and smooth functioning of the program activities. The Headquarter and working areas of the organization is 60 kilometers away from the capital city Dhaka and it takes at least 6 hours by road and crossing river Padma(Ganges)to reach SKS.

Objective of SKS

- Helping the poor to advocate for equal rights, access to resources and opportunities especially focusing on the disadvantaged people and minorities.
- Promoting rights of women and children.

Vision of SKS

Improve health and education sector especially of the hard core poor women and children and see Bangladesh as a respectable country in the global map.

Mission of SKS

The overall aim of SKS is the socio-economic development of vulnerable groups through group formation, employment creation and comprehensive reproductive health services.

Goal of SKS

The foundation to be created for the well being of the hard core poor in the rural and urban areas in Bangladesh.
